Dear Commissioner Campbell:

This letter is to inform you that at its meeting held on Friday, June 17, 2011 the Strafford Metropolitan Planning Organization (SMPO) Policy Committee approved Amendment #2 to the SMPO's 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) with changes as proposed by UNH and accepted by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT). The amendments made were shown in the attached legal notice that was published in Foster's newspaper, at the Rochester and Dover Public Libraries, and on the SRPC/SMPO website: www.strafford.org.

TIP Amendment #2 was approved following the appropriate public notice, a 30-day comment period that started on May 15, 2011 and ended on June 16, 2011, and public hearing held on June 17, 2011 as required for a full TIP amendment by our Prospectus.

Through the interagency consultation process it was determined that Amendment #2 required a new Air Quality Determination to account for the projects being added to the 2011-2014 TIP. SMPO, in consultation with NHDOT, NHDES, USEPA, FHWA, FTA, and the other NH MPOs, has confirmed that the changes made by the proposed Amendment #2 to the adopted NHDOT 2011-2014 STIP will result in a slight reduction in regional emissions for the SMPO non-attainment area. This determination establishes that the proposed changes do not impact our air quality conformity status.

The SMPO Policy Committee approved TIP Amendment #2. This action taken by the Policy Committee officially amends the SMPO 2011-2014 TIP to incorporate the changes indicated.
